

Baby Friendly Spaces Program Checklist

Our business or organization meets the below criteria of the Baby Friendly Spaces Program:

- Our business/organization encourages families to feed their children anytime, anywhere.
- Staff and volunteers are aware that our business or organization is part of the Baby Friendly Spaces Program and are aware of the following key messages of the program:
 - Breastfeeding is a human right.
 - Families can feed their child anytime, anywhere and cannot be asked to move, cover-up or stop feeding.
 - If someone expresses a negative concern about a woman breastfeeding, the family is not made aware that a concern has been expressed.
 - If a parent prefers a quiet location, provide one if possible.
 - If there is an option, a family with a young child is given the choice where to sit.
- The staff tips poster is in a location that all staff and volunteers can see.
- Information about the Baby Friendly Spaces Program is part of staff orientation.
- The international “Breastfeeding is Welcome Here” symbol is posted at entrances.
