Drop in Play— Is unstructured free play time for families to enjoy and explore our centres invitations and offerings.

Public Health Nurse— This is one-on-one time for parents/caregivers to ask questions related to their baby/child's specific development, feeding journeys, and an opportunity to weigh baby/child. Offered in partnership with Saskatchewan Health Authority.

Art Adventures— Parents and Children are exposed to different art mediums through preplanned weekly classes that they can use to make a masterpiece. This program focuses on the process over the product and is intended for children 2-5 years old.

Mini-Movers – Parents and children are exposed to interactive gross motor and spatial awareness activities. This program is intended for children crawling to 5 years old.

RPHN Peer Support Group— Peer support group for parents/caregivers suffering from pre/postnatal anxiety and perinatal depression, offered in partnership with Regina Perinatal Health Network.

RPHN NICU Peer Support Group— Peer support group offered biweekly for parents that had babies spend time in the NICU, offered in partnership with Regina Perinatal Health Network.

Ask Allie— This one-on-one time for parents/caregivers to ask questions to an Autism Navigator about all things related to Autism including diagnosis/referrals, supports, coregulation, and other strategies to support Autistic children or families possibly seeking Autism diagnosis. Offered in partnership with Saskatchewan Health Authority.

Playful Development ASQ Program— Weekly activities for parents/caregivers and children 0-5 years old that connect developmental milestones and emerging skills form the ASQ program to hand on learning and play-based activities.

Child Care Readiness Presentation—Online and in person session for families that offers information to help parents support their children in their transition to childcare.

Triple P Positive Parenting online group sessions— Triple P facilitator Dunja has put together mini zoom sessions for parents to provide education and strategies related to common parenting challenges.

Literacy in the Park—Join us at Goki Park for some fun activities Lets get moving with Literacy! Please come dressed appropriately for the weather. This location has a spray park too.

Maple Leaf Pool— Join the facilitators at the Maple Leaf Free pool located at 1101 14th ave for swim and sweet treat. Assisted floating devices are not provided please bring your own if your child needs one. Facilitators will not be in the swimming pool you must swim with your own child. There is no cost to go swimming at this location it is always free.

Super Adventure— Join staff from both our EYFRC locations and Regina Literacy Hub Coordinator Sandi White for a funtastic superhero adventure and make a Super mask at Candy Cane Park 501 Wascana Drive please remember to dress for the weather.
